Qurbani meat pack beneficiaries, Kenya 2019

In 2019 (1440AH) Alhamdulillah we have managed to implement 155,295 Qurbanis and distributed 554,411 Qurbani meat packs in 34 countries and areas in Asia, Africa and Eastern Europe reaching 3,139,813 beneficiaries, people who are struggling to get their daily meals to sustain their lives and wellbeing. The total budget for the Qurbani Programme in 2019 was €11,454,514.

Qurbani Programme Insha Allah will continue targeting the most vulnerable groups and people living with food insecurity; we will continue our efforts to reach and access people who live in remote areas and thus are extra disadvantaged. Our aim is to make the programme as efficient and cost effective as possible so that the beneficiaries get the maximum benefit from it.

Islamic Relief Worldwide and the millions of beneficiaries would like to thank the donors from around the world for their generosity, and the colleagues in the different fundraising positions for their hard work. Through these two sources we have been able to generate the funds from which Islamic Relief Worldwide is able to execute one of its largest annual projects. Introduction

Qurbani (or Udhiya) is a religious rite involving the sacrifice of an animal during specific days in the Islamic calendar. Muslims around the world undertake the ritual in commemoration of the sacrifice of the Prophet Ibrahim of a ram as a divine dispensation in lieu of the original command to sacrifice his son, Prophet Ismail. The performance of Qurbani is either wajib (obligatory) or sunnah mu'akkadah (emphasised Prophetic practice) on those who fulfil the pre-conditions (e.g. adulthood, possession of sufficient wealth, resident, freedom etc.).

The animal selected must also meet specific requirements regarding health, age and being free from defects which are stipulated in the Shariah (religious law). The date for sacrifice is also time-specific with its validity being conditional on being performed within 10th – 13th Dhul Hijjah, the tenth month of the Islamic calendar.

Traditionally, the meat obtained from the sacrificial animal is split into three shares and consumed by the one performing the sacrifice, family and friends, and donated to those living in poverty. However, it is permissible to donate the entire animal and its meat to others. Islamic Relief Worldwide, through the annual Qurbani Programme, facilitates the performance of Qurbani on behalf of donors and the distribution of the meat generated to countless beneficiaries globally.

Islamic Relief has been implementing the Qurbani Programme in excess of 30 years and acts as an agent on behalf of the donor to fulfil this act of worship. Islamic Relief takes this obligation very seriously as the conditions to ensure the validity and acceptability of the sacrifice are very specific. This poses serious logistical challenges but the experience and hard-work of staff and volunteers across the Islamic Relief family enable the discharging of this duty on behalf of the donor.

The Qurbani Programme is the largest programme in the Seasonal Programme family with more than 30 projects implemented during the same 2-4 week period funded by numerous Islamic Relief Partners and other Partner agencies. 
Section 3 forms the bulk of the report and contains the Field Office summary sheets for each of country.

Our Impact







We responded to humanitarian emergencies triggered by conflict and natural disasters around the world. Helping vulnerable communities experiencing food insecurity to enjoy fresh halal safe Qurbani meat on the occasion of Eid al-Adha.

Method of Implementation

The programme is designed to operate in conjunction with other relief and development programmes that provide more sustainable assistance in improving living conditions for people in need.

The Qurbani sacrifice is a time-limited event and must occur between sunrise of 10th Dhul Hijjah to before dusk of 13th Dhul Hijjah. As soon as Eid prayers are completed in the morning of 10th Dhul Hijjah the slaughter commences from around 6.30am in the morning in most locations.

The key aspects for the validity of the Qurbani is for it:

- to be performed in the set time period (10th 13th Dhul Hijjah)
- to be in accordance with the Shariah rules of slaughter
- to be offered with a healthy animal suitable for slaughter

The mere distribution of meat packs isn't sufficient to achieve the aims of this programme; the criteria for a legally valid Qurbani must also be met. In order to achieve this the following procedures are followed appropriate to local norms.

Method of Implementation

Observing the time-restriction (10th -13th Dhul Hijjah)

There is some disagreement amongst the scholars regarding the time period during which Qurbani can be performed. The two major opinions are:

- 1. 10th 12th Dhul Hijjah
- 2. 10th 13th Dhul Hijjah

In order to achieve the broadest level of acceptability, Islamic Relief strives to achieve all Qurbanis by the 12th Dhul Hijjah and thus avoid any dispute regarding validity. However, due to both the numbers of Qurbanis received in some of the most popular field offices and the local acceptability for Qurbani to be performed up to 13th Dhul Hijjah, Islamic Relief permits Qurbani up to 13th Dhul Hijjah with the caveat that this is acceptable as Qurbani in the locality of implementation.

In this manner, the Qurbani Programme strives to achieve all Qurbanis within a universally acceptable time-frame whilst permitting extension into the fourth day (13th Dhul Hijjah) considering ground realities, local practice and operational capacity.

Observing the rules of slaughter

The general principles of Islamic slaughter are agreed, that the animal be slaughtered by a Muslim with the name of Allah mentioned over the animal and that the slaughter takes place with a blade on the neck of the animal. The finer details of method of slaughter are differed upon e.g. which vessels of the neck are to be cut, whether the name of Allah is omitted un/intentionally etc.

To ensure reliability a number of methods are used. When the slaughter is conducted at slaughter-houses/abattoirs, halal regulated vendors are selected; when slaughter is conducted on a community-led basis then skilled slaughtermen are recruited familiar with the Islamic laws of slaughter. In both cases, Islamic Relief representatives and regularly Imams are present to monitor the slaughter process and ensure compliance with the Islamic guidelines.

Observing the health of livestock

The animals selected for Qurbani must be healthy, free from defects and of specific minimum age depending on the animal selected. From procurement process through to time of slaughter, livestock are continually monitored by Islamic Relief staff and volunteers to ensure suitability. Veterinarians and technical services from government are also involved to ensure livestock are healthy, disease-free and suitable for human consumption.

Livestock which are not suitable, either from a Shariah perspective or from a medical perspective, are rejected and suppliers are contracted to provide suitable and acceptable replacements.

Method of Implementation

Distribution

There are two main methods of distribution:

Fresh Meat Distribution

The majority of Qurbanis are implemented as fresh meat distributions. Animals are purchased locally, or the closest neighbouring country, depending on availability, price and its effect on local market. They are then slaughtered and the meat is distributed immediately amongst the selected beneficiaries.

The act of Qurbani, alongside its religious significance, is also a communal event in many parts of the Muslim world and ownership is given to beneficiaries by including them in implementation of Qurbani. Local butchers and Imams are on hand to facilitate the humane and Shariah-compliance of the slaughter with beneficiaries often present providing logistical support.

Fresh meat may either be slaughtered on sight at the distribution point or at abattoirs and then transported to the distribution sites via refrigerated vehicles.

Chilled Meat Distribution

Islamic Relief Worldwide tries very hard to provide Partners the best in terms of price and the quality of the Qurbani meat. Following on from last year's success we have again this year offered Chilled Meat distribution in Jordan. Animal prices in some of the Middle Eastern countries are exceptionally high because most of the animals are usually imported from other countries. Animals were purchased & slaughtered in Romania according to the Shariah principles. They were then shipped to Jordan by maintaining the cold chain where the meat was kept chilled but not frozen. Qurbani meat distribution to the beneficiaries started on the 3rd day of Eid al-Adha and completed the following day.

In some countries because of the distance from abattoir to distribution sites, meat is hygienically packed and chilled before transportation. Due to the large numbers of Qurbanis performed in some field offices, it is logistically not possible to distribute the meat on the same day as slaughter takes place. In this instance, the meat is stored in cool stores before transportation on the following day/s.

Beneficiary Selection

Once allocations are communicated to field offices from the Seasonal Programmes team among the first tasks to be completed is that of selecting appropriate beneficiaries. The strength of Islamic Relief Worldwide lies in the fact our colleagues are already based and working in the countries of Qurbani Programme implementation.

The offices already have access to a database of potential beneficiaries or alternatively have strong working relationships with local community organisations who can help identify or suggest potential beneficiaries. A strong example of potential beneficiaries already existent within the organisational framework and knowledge are those whom are currently sponsored or awaiting sponsorship via the Orphan Sponsorship Programme (OSP). Many field offices integrate the Seasonal Programmes with the most vulnerable households currently sponsored via the OSP.

As the need far exceeds the allocation a scoring criteria is adopted to identify the most vulnerable individuals and households based on needs assessment. In this manner an objective standard is applied in the beneficiary selection process to ensure that the food aid reaches those in severest need. This also serves well in cases of conflict to justify the selection of some over others.

This year a wide range of beneficiaries were selected; they included categories such as widows, orphaned children, destitute, individuals of advanced aged, individuals living with disability, refugees and people affected by disasters. The beneficiaries are selected in conjunction with local welfare groups working alongside Islamic Relief offices in a given country.

Beneficiaries are verified by Islamic Relief staff. This verification is conducted to ensure the most vulnerable members of the community are served and usually consists of a home-visit where data is cross-checked and gathered against pre-assessment forms. At these verification meetings, ID is checked and upon successful completion vouchers are supplied to rights-holders. The vouchers contain key information with respect to the beneficiary – name, age, ID number, contact number etc. along with the Meat Pack distribution site, date of distribution and Meat Pack content.

These vouchers are kept by the beneficiary until distribution day where they are presented to at the registration desk and verified once more before Meat Packs are disbursed.

Procurement Process

All Islamic Relief field offices adhere to the Islamic Relief Procurement Process Guidelines with public advertisement and invitation of tenders conducted in local media. Suitable bids are then invited to a selection process and the details of the tender are discussed in further detail with a selection committee comprising of 4-5 people – including Country Director, Finance and Programmes staff.

All efforts are made to source livestock from local suppliers with respect to distribution points in order to mitigate animal welfare issues associated with long distance transport and to facilitate the delivery of fresh and safe meat packs. In countries with mixed Muslim and non-Muslim populations, inspections are carried out to ensure slaughter facilities are Shariah compliant and free from pork products.

Livestock is procured from both local markets (e.g. IR Bangladesh) and slaughter houses (e.g. IR Albania). In the majority of cases, suppliers are also charged with slaughtering, skinning, cutting, and packing of meat packs, and transportation to distribution points. In this manner monitoring can be adequately achieved at place of purchase to maintain safety standards and Shariah-compliance for which both Shariah advisers (Ulama) and Veterinarians are present alongside field colleagues. Transportation is conducted in refrigerated vehicles to preserve the freshness and longevity of meat packs. In some locations livestock is handed over to village/camp committees and local volunteers, as was the case in parts of Niger this year, for community-based slaughter and stakeholder participation to be enabled.

Local Partners

Strong local partnerships are key in implementing an effective Qurbani meat pack distribution project. Local partners include local government institutions, NGOs, community and social welfare organisations, civil society and local security personnel.

Qurbani is widely performed throughout much of the developing world on both an organisational level by NGOs and on an individual level. In order to avoid duplication of distribution, field office teams engage with local government to identify communities not currently being served by either government food assistance projects or other charitable endeavours. In this manner, we ensure that one household does not receive two Meat Packs from Islamic Relief whilst other deserving households are deprived.

Local NGOs are a useful source of identifying potential beneficiaries. However, the verification of beneficiaries is conducted by Islamic Relief staff to ensure that only those who meet our criteria and score most highly are selected as beneficiaries.

Security personnel such as local police may be informed after livestock have been procured and received to assist with site security at storage facilities in areas where security is an issue. This would be in addition to the arrangements already engaged by Islamic Relief to guard holding sites. Typically, local police may be requested to step up patrols around facilities to help deter any unwanted

attention. The beneficiary community also plays a role in providing security. Due to the Qurbani taking place during the summer heat in most field offices, animals are transported at night to reduce heat stress. This necessitates housing the livestock for the night prior to slaughter, community based organisations play a crucial role in managing the storage in the night.

Islamic Relief field offices are extremely reliant on volunteers when it comes to the Qurbani Programme. The scale of the Qurbanis performed and the extremely short time frame means that the volunteers who assist with distribution site management and co-ordination between slaughter house, transportation and beneficiaries are crucial.

A small stipend is paid to volunteers to cover food and transportation costs but this is not a recompense for the extreme hard work and diligence exhibited by volunteers.

All local partners and volunteers are screened as per the IRW screening policy to ensure that relationships are built and cultivated with reliable and genuine organisation. This is also essential to minimise the risk for Islamic Relief with respect to entering an exploitative or illegal practice.

Lessons Learnt and Recommendations

- 1. One of the biggest challenges we face every year is the late transfer of Qurbani funds to the field offices. For the project to run well, funds should be transferred to the field offices at least 6-8 weeks before Eid al-Adha. This would allow our field offices to buy good quality animals at the best possible prices. It would also allow for better logistical planning and ensure higher standards are maintained at all stages of the Qurbani process. For this to happen, our funding Partners should transfer Seasonal funds at least 8 weeks in advance.
- 2. High animal and logistics costs in the field offices are impacting Qurbani prices. Islamic Relief fundraising Partners are encouraged to educate donors about the good quality of our work. All our programmes are designed in line with the International Humanitarian Standards e.g. Sphere Standards, International Humanitarian Law, ICRC code of conduct etc. While this may increase the cost of the Qurbani, donors are getting better value for money. At the same time, beneficiaries, many in remote areas, are getting good quality Qurbani meat.
- 3. The standards of "good" animal welfare vary considerably between IR field offices. This is an area which requires huge improvements in all our field offices. Special efforts are needed to make sure the following steps are taken into consideration while dealing with the Qurbani animals at the field level:
 - Freedom from thirst and hunger by ready access to fresh water and a diet to maintain full health and vigour
 - Freedom from discomfort by providing an appropriate environment including shelter and a comfortable resting area
 - Freedom from pain, injury, and disease by prevention or rapid diagnosis and treatment.
 - Freedom to express most normal behaviour by providing sufficient space, proper facilities, and company of the animal's own kind
 - Freedom from fear and distress by ensuring conditions and treatment which avoid mental suffering.


- 4. It is suggested to conduct an orientation session prior to distribution days for the benefit of volunteers and staff. Essential components of this would include good practice with respect to hygiene, slaughtering and meat handling as well as conducting simulated delivery/ donation point exercises to facilitate smoother delivery on the distribution days.
- 5. Preparation of supplementary list of beneficiaries will further increase the wider impact and benefit greater number of beneficiaries as certain countries consistently are generating additional meat packs due to favourable prices. This year 22 countries out of 33 have exceeded the allocation of meat packs. Anticipating this increase in advance meat packs coupled with similar experience from previous years entails that for future project planning a supplementary list of beneficiaries is prepared with an adequate communications system in place to ensure timely and adequate distribution.
- 6. The nature of the challenges across this year's 34 field offices share similar themes logistics, preservation of meat packs in hygienic conditions, timely sacrifice and distribution etc. Good practice and suggestions from each field office will be shared across all implementing offices in order to share best practice, enhance organisational learning and continually improve on our current achievements.
- 7. A system needs to be in place to ensure that the allocated number of Qurbanis for each field office are achieved as a minimum. This is due to the religious significance of Qurbani. Field offices which were unable to achieve the allocation must learn lessons and enact changes to prevent further occurrences.
- 8. In some distribution sites there was potential for conflict where both sheep and goat meat was distributed amongst beneficiaries with various parties expressing preference for one type of meat over the other. It is strongly recommended to ensure that at each distribution point only one type of acceptable meat is distributed to avoid potential conflict between beneficiaries.




